Operations Update:   Joe Angevine

1. February was a quiet month, March has started to pick up with the nicer weather.
2. New shop construction is progressing, concrete pouring ongoing. Fibre optic conduit and vault should be installed over the next few weeks.
3. Alberta Environment and Protected Areas (AEPA) completed a surprise audit on site. Mostly minor items that have been addressed. Audit report submitted to AEPA. One remaining issue left to renew compost certification.
4. Phyto-remediation pad project moving ahead, waiting on soil analysis for mix design and have been in touch with U of C to get involved to study the effectiveness of the system. Grant funding should be available.
5. Seasonals staff have returned. Joint Salvage Centre position has been posted.
6. Concrete crusher on site to crush concrete and shred mattresses. Shredded mattresses will be landfilled.
7. Compost screening for the final section of the biocover coming up. Project should wrap up this summer.

New Compactor Options: Joe Angevine discussed new compactor purchase options.
