Location: SW 13-19-27 W4

Marker Date: July 1, 2011



This site is one of the oldest historic school sites within the MD of Foothills still providing schooling and enjoys the laughter of children in the playground every school day. As with many other schools, Blackie School went through a number of reconfigurations and additions. A two story building was built in 1925 with a new school being built in 1959, 8 new classrooms were added to the collection of school buildings. The original building was demolished. Blackie School remains an important community hub for the Hamlet of Blackie and surrounding area. It is the site of one of the first markers for the MD's School marker program.
