

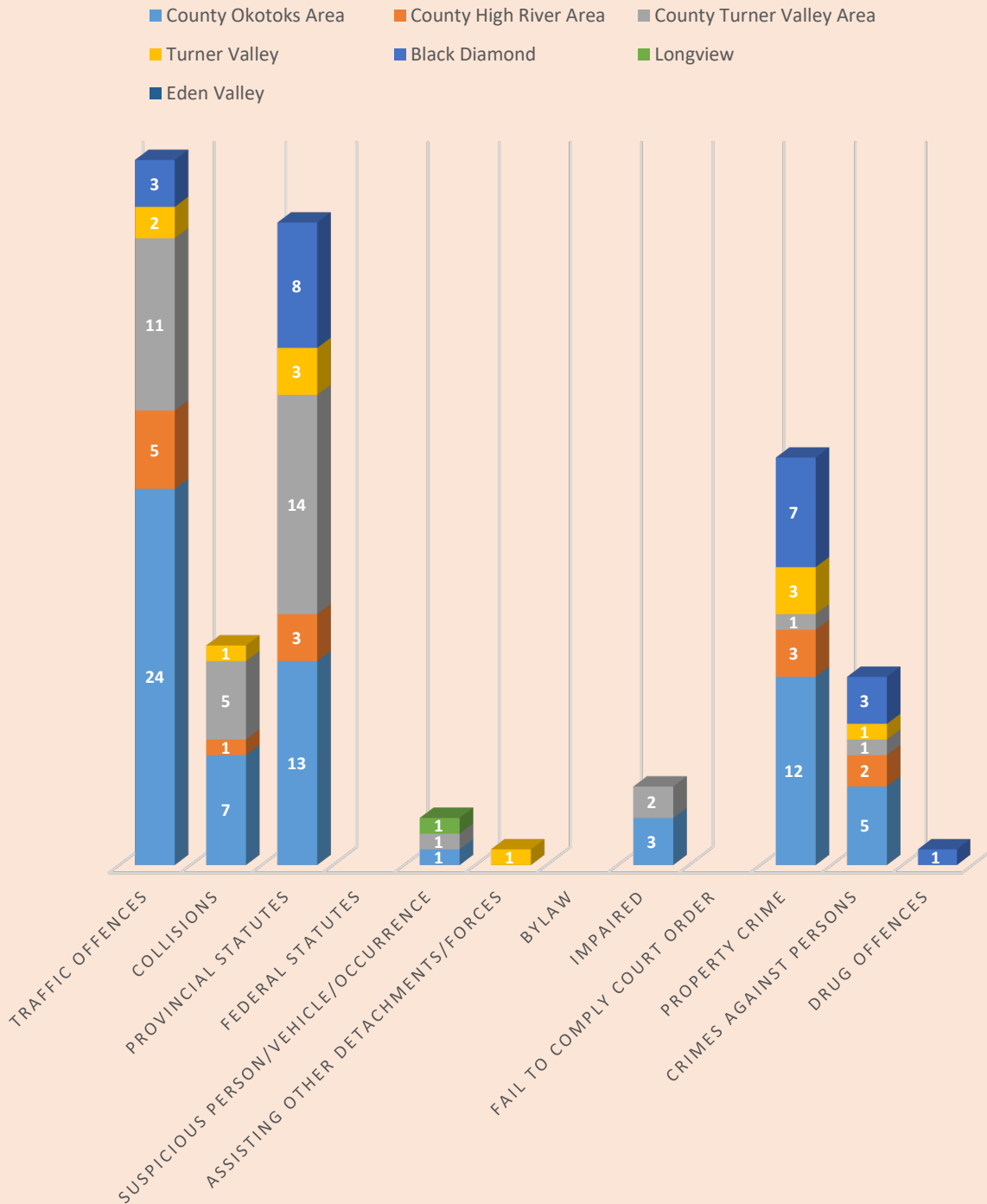

#### **WHAT WENT ON LAST WEEK?**

On May 15, Foothills County RCMP responded with the Foothills Fire Department to a grass fire on Hwy 22 near Hwy 22X. RCMP conducted traffic control while the Foothills Fire Dept. quickly extinguished the fire.

On May 15, Foothills RCMP responded to a complaint of an erratic driver on hwy 2 near 466 Ave. The vehicle was located and stopped. The female driver failed a mandatory alcohol screening, resulting in a license suspension, fine, and vehicle impound.

On May 15, a catalytic converter was cut out of a vehicle that was parked at a baseball tournament near Okotoks. No suspects have been identified.

On May 16, Foothills County RCMP received a complaint that a catalytic converter had been cut out of an RV parked at a storage facility near Okotoks. The matter is still under investigation.

On May 16, Foothills County RCMP assisted Calgary Police with locating a person in mental distress. The client was safely located and transported to hospital by EMS.

On May 16, Foothills County RCMP received two complaints of a driveway paving scam. A male, still to be identified, solicited several residences near Hwy 22X to provide paving services, being very pushy and demanding upfront payments. The company the male stated he worked for does not exist. The suspect did not gain any funds from his intended victims, but did try cashing a post-dated cheque from one homeowner at a bank in Calgary. Foothills RCMP are working with the bank to identify the suspect. \*\*\*Officer's note: beware of high pressure tactics, aimed on gaining a financial commitment/ payment up front for future services. If you're suspicious of a solicitor, call police\*\*\*

On May 17, Foothills RCMP responded to a call of an abandoned trailer and skid steer on 112 Street in Foothills County. Investigation revealed the trailer had been stolen out of Calgary. The trailer and equipment was returned to its rightful owner. No suspects have been identified.

On May 17, Foothills County RCMP responded to a complaint of a male walking along hwy 2, not dressed for conditions. The male was located and taken to medical care.

On May 17, Foothills County and High River RCMP responded to a complaint of male lying on the shoulder of hwy 2 near High River. The male was located and transported to hospital for a mental health assessment.

On May 20, Foothills County RCMP responded to a theft of a van in Black Diamond. An adult relative of the complainant was charged with theft of the vehicle, which has since been recovered.

On May 21, Foothills County RCMP responded to a vehicle in the ditch on 208 Street West. The unlicensed male driver failed to comply with a mandatory alcohol screening, resulting in a license suspension, fine, Violation tickets, and vehicle impound.

2022663842 – On May 21, Foothills County RCMP received a complaint of neglected cattle. The complaint was forwarded to the SPCA for investigation.

2022679260 – On May 21, a Turner Valley resident was the victim of a phone scam, losing over \$3000. The male received a call from somebody posing as bank security and ultimately purchased over \$3000 in prepaid gift cards and provided the numbers over the phone to the scammer. \*\*\*Officer's note: these types of scams typically originate from overseas so once the money is gone, it's usually gone for good. No reputable business will ever ask for payment over the phone using prepaid gift cards. Always do your due diligence before providing payment for anything. \*\*\*

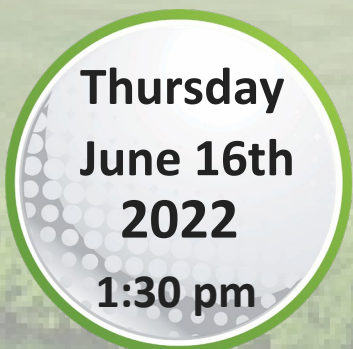

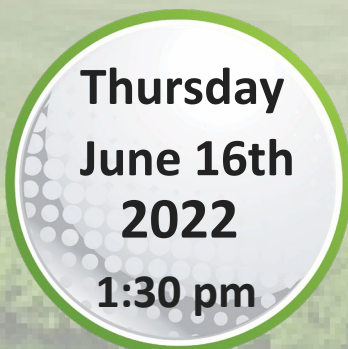
