

RCMP TURNER VALLEY DETACHMENT

What happened the week of 2022-07-10 to 2022-07-16

2022-07-11 Foothills County RCMP

- Report of a barking dog at a residence near a campground near Okotoks. No dog was found at the location. Campground host was advised.
- Report made of a theft of an automobile near Coalmine Road, Foothills County. Unsolved at this point.
- A report came in requesting a well-being check on a male driver parked under an overpass on Highway 2. Patrols were made. The truck was not located.
- A break and enter to a business overnight in Black Diamond was reported. No suspects at this point.

2022-07-12 Foothills County RCMP

- A 911 call was received with only static on the line. On call back the line rang once and then went to static. Member attended the business and confirmed all was well. This is a common phone line issue in the County.
- A trespasser at night in the Foothills County near Okotoks was reported, The subjects of complaint went into an open garage and were scared off when the home owner opened the front door. The subjects left in an unknown vehicle.
- A report of a house break and enter was received in a community near Okotoks in the Foothills County. This file is still under investigation.
- A suspicious person who was half naked was reported in Kananaskis. Not enough evidence at this time to pursue charges.

2022-07-13 Foothills County RCMP

- Early in the morning RCMP issued a roadside suspension to a driver on Highway 7 near Okotoks. The vehicle was towed.
- Stolen vehicle with driver located parked near Okotoks at Dunbow Road in the Foothills County. Driver arrested and charged with possession of stolen property. The driver also had a warrant which was executed.

- Report of a naked male near the Sheep River in Turner Valley. No male located.
 Complainant was advised if male seen again call immediately so police can action the call.
- Report made regarding an ongoing issue with drugs in an area in Black Diamond.
 Description of vehicle given. More patrols being made.

2022-07-14 Foothills County RCMP

- A 911 call made about a possible impaired driver on Highway 2 near High River.. Vehicle located and driver received a roadside suspension. Vehicle was towed.
- A complainant in Foothills County reported that they had received a call from their credit
 card company advising their credit card had been compromised. The caller knew the
 complainants name and credit card number. The caller helped the complainant "reactivate"
 their card with a new PIN while on the phone with them. The caller was not from the
 credit card company and fraudulent charges were made on the credit card. The file is still
 under investigation.

2022-07-15 Foothills County RCMP

•	A report of a suspicious person near Okotoks was caught on the complainants back yard
	camera cutting through the yard and walking close to the complainants patio doors and
	through the neighbors yard. Reported the day after the incident. No one located.

COMMUNITY NOTES

Criminal Record Checks

As summer draws to an end, everyone is going back to work from vacation, getting ready for school, and preparing to volunteer in the fall. A lot of these will require a criminal record check to be completed. A few notes to remember about getting a criminal record check.

- You must attend the detachment which covers your area. The Turner Valley RCMP covers all of Foothills County with the exception of the town of Okotoks and the town of High River.
- 2. You must physically attend the detachment to fill out the form requesting a criminal record check with two pieces of valid government issued ID. Only one must be a photo ID. Your driver license must have your current address.
- 3. If you are volunteering, bring your volunteer letter requesting the RCMP to perform the check.
- 4. Know the full name of the business / organization and their address for the request form.
- 5. Allow time for the results. Depending on the type of check you are having done, the time may vary from a few days to a few weeks.
