### YOU CAN FILE A REPORT IF:

- You have lost something that cost less than \$5000.00
- Someone has stolen something from you that costs less than \$5000.00
- Someone has vandalized your property or vehicle and it will cost less that \$5000.00 to repair it
- The crime happened within the jurisdiction of the Alberta RCMP
- Thefts over \$5000.00 are accepted from oil, telecommunications and utility companies

### YOU CAN NOT USE THE ONLINE CRIME REPORTING IF:

- There is a witness or suspect
- There are lost or stolen items involving personal identity, firearms, licence plates or decals

<u>All crimes</u> reported online to the Alberta RCMP will be followed up with a phone call from a police officer within five business days.
