PURPOSE OF REQUEST

For Council to review the implementation and installation of a stop sign at the intersection of 210 Avenue West & 256 Street West as shown on the attached map.

BACKGROUND

The intersection was redesigned to accommodate the higher flow of traffic south bound to Whiskey Springs Sub-Division; the stop sign will replace the current yield sign.

FINANCIAL

This will require 1 sign at a cost of \$250.

REQUEST OF COUNCIL

Council may choose to provide first reading to the Bylaw to authorize a STOP sign installation at the location described.

BYLAW XX/2025

**BEING A BYLAW OF FOOTHILLS COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO
AUTHORIZE THE ERECTION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS**

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that a STOP sign be erected at the intersection of 210 Avenue West and 256 Street West.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provision of the Traffic Safety Act, being Chapter T-6, R.S.A. 2000, and amendment thereto, the Council of Foothills County in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That Council authorize the installation of a STOP sign (RA-1) at the intersection of 210 Avenue West and 256 Street West and removal of the existing YIELD sign (RA-2).
2. This Bylaw shall have effect on the date of its third reading and upon being signed.
