Northwest Recreation

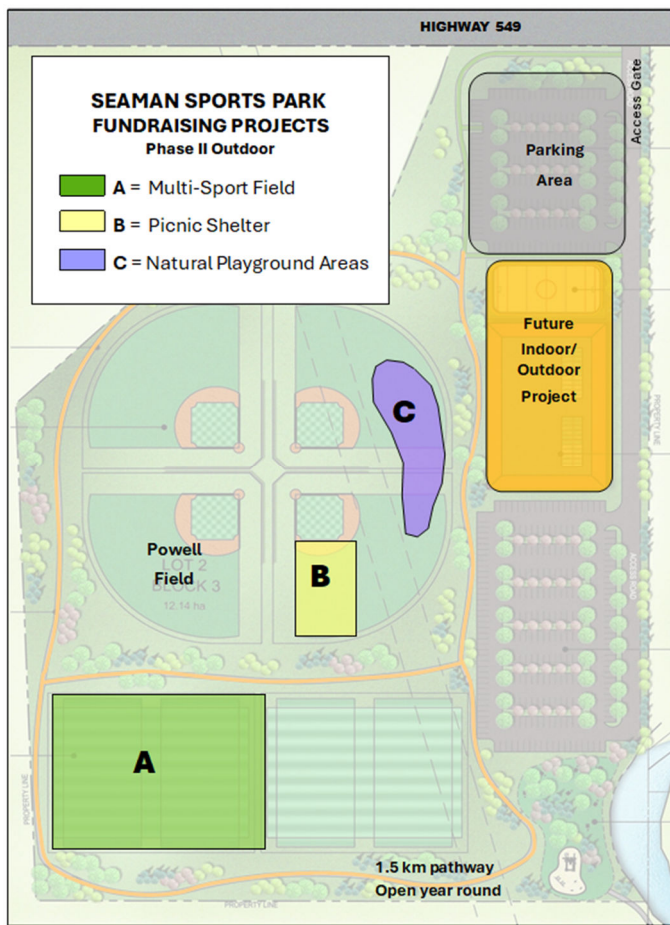
The Northwest Recreation Board (NWREC) was founded in 2010 to explore and develop recreation projects within Council Divisions 3, 4 and 5 of Foothills County (Millarville, Priddis, Red Deer Lake & De Winton Areas). NWREC is a Committee of Foothills County Council.

Our Mission

To work with the residents and established Associations within Foothills County, Divisions 3, 4, and 5, to identify their recreation requirements and engage the communities in the development and provision of recreational facilities without impacting taxes.

Welcome to Seaman Sports Park!

Seaman Sports Park (SSP) is located directly south of Highway 549, approximately 0.8 km east of HWY 549 and Highway 22 intersection. Visitors to the SSP have access to a parking area, pathway, and seasonal washroom facilities. The Millarville Sports Association (MSA) manages bookings of the two regulation size baseball diamonds in the park; visit MSA millarvillesports.ca for further information. The park and pathway are open during the winter, but the gates are closed because the driveway, grounds, and pathway are not maintained. Please note that park users enter and use the park at their own risk. Pets are to be leashed at all times in the park.
