

1. MAKE YOUR PRESENTATION TO THE BOARD IN PERSON OR VIA ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCING/CONFERENCE CALLING

You may either appear in person at the Foothills Administration Building or participate via Zoom Video Conferencing/Conference calling. In order to participate, you must first register by email to appeals@foothillscountyab.ca and include the following information:

- **Name of Applicant, Application, or File Number, and Date and Time of the Appeal Board Hearing(s) you are attending**
- **Your Name** (you must use the same spelling when registering and when signing in through Zoom)
- **How you will attend the Hearing** (i.e., in-person, by video conference, or by telephone (conference call))
- **Email address**
- **Mailing address**
- **Phone number** (for contact purposes in case there are technical difficulties during the hearing)
- **Your purpose for attending** (i.e., appellant, agent, neighbouring landowner in support of, or in opposition to, the application, etc.)

Deadline for registration is 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 8, 2026. Late registrations will not be accepted. Once registered, an email with detailed instructions will be sent to you within 48 hours of the scheduled hearing date and time.

If you wish to include a letter or written submission, it can be sent by email to appeals@foothillscountyab.ca, by Fax (403) 652-7880, by regular mail to Foothills County, Box 5605 High River, Alberta T1V 1M7, or dropped off in the mailbox at the front door of the Foothills Administration Building. Written submissions **must** be received by **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 8, 2026.**

2. MAKE YOUR PRESENTATION TO THE BOARD VIA WRITTEN SUBMISSION

If you are unable to participate in person or electronically, you may submit a letter in advance of the appeal board hearing. Letters must be received by **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 8, 2026** to allow for circulation to all parties. Letters can be submitted by email to appeals@foothillscountyab.ca, Fax (403) 652-7880, by regular mail to Foothills County, Box 5605 High River, Alberta T1V 1M7, or dropped off in the mailbox at the front door of the Foothills Administration Building. Letters must include the following information:

- **Name of Applicant, Application, or File Number, and Date and Time of the Appeal Board Hearing(s) you are making comment on**
- **Your Name** (you must use the same spelling when registering and when signing in)
- **Email address**
- **Mailing address**
- **Phone number** (for contact purposes in case there are technical difficulties during the hearing)
